





Higher education enrollment, per 1000 hab.




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
#### Growth of HE enrollment in Europe, per 1000 hab




### Comparing (%) the level of schooling of parents of students in universities and polytechnics.




### Family income and choice of higher education sub-system.



### First year enrolments by gender and disciplinary area




### Students starting Medicine (DGES, Lisbon)




### Students enrolled in higher education for the first time






### Average annual tuition fees charged by tertiary- type A public institutions for full time students (2006-7).

#### Public subsidies for tertiary education




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
